Directions to Grandover from Piedmont Triad International airport: (16 Miles)

Enter onto Bryan Blvd. taking the Winston-Salem/High Point exit.
Bryan Blvd will turn into Highway 68 South. Continue South on Highway 68, for 2 miles.
Exit onto Interstate 40 East.
Continue East on Interstate 40, for 8 miles.
Exit onto Highway 220 South, for 1 mile.
Take the Interstate 85 South exit. Continue South on Interstate 85.
Exit on and turn right onto Groometown Road.
Next block turn left onto Grandover Parkway.
Continue South 1 mile on Grandover Parkway to the Resort.

Directions to Piedmont Triad International airport: (16 Miles)

Turn left onto Grandover Parkway, for 1 mile.
Next block turn right onto Groometown Road.
Enter onto Interstate 85 North, for 4 miles.
Exit onto Highway 220 North, for 1 mile.
Take the Interstate 40 West to Winston-Salem exit.
Continue West on Interstate 40, for 8 miles.
Take the Highway 68 North/Airport exit.
Continue for 2 miles, following signs to the airport.

Arriving from the North (Virginia, Washington DC):

Follow Interstate 85 South, towards Charlotte.
Exit on and turn right onto Groometown Road.
Turn left at the first stoplight onto Grandover Parkway.
The Resort entrance is on the right at 1 mile.

Arriving from the South (Charlotte, Atlanta):

Follow Interstate 85 North, towards Greensboro.
 Exit on and turn left onto Groometown Road.
 Turn left at the first stoplight onto Grandover Parkway.
 The Resort entrance is on the right at 1 mile.

Arriving from the East (Durham,Raleigh):

Follow Interstate 40 West, into Greensboro.
 Turn left onto Interstate 85 South, towards Charlotte.
 Exit on and turn right onto Groometown Road.
 Turn left at the first stoplight onto Grandover Parkway.
 The Resort entrance is on the right at 1 mile.

Arriving from the West (Winston-Salem):

Follow Interstate 40 East, into Greensboro.
 Exit onto Highway 220 South, for 1 mile.
 Take the Interstate 85 South exit.
 Continue South on Interstate 85, for 4 miles.
 Exit on and turn right onto Groometown Road.
 Next block turn left onto Grandover Parkway.
 Continue South 1 mile on Grandover Parkway to the Resort.

AIRLINES:

Piedmont Triad International Airport (20 minutes from Grandover) serves the Triad area of Greensboro, Winston Salem and High Point with major commercial and general aviation services. Carriers include: American, Delta, Continental, United, US Airways, Northwest, Independence Air. PTIA offers daily non-stop flights to more than 20 cities.

DRIVING:

Converging major highways make Greensboro an easy destination for travelers. North/South Interstate 85 and East/West Interstate 40 cross Greensboro, as do Highways 29, 70, 220 and 421.

TRAIN:

Service by Amtrak directly to 50 cities, with connections to over 500 cities.
