A&T) have partnered to host the **2020 Greensboro AHEC / NC A&T Preprofessional Scholars Summer Experience (PPSSE)**. The PPSSE is designed to prepare incoming freshmen, rising sophomores, and transfer students for the challenge of navigating the path to professional and graduate school. **This 3-day virtual program** will provide a solid foundation by:

To Register for the PPSSE program:

- 2) You will receive an email to verifying your registration.
