About the CURE Mobile Website

The CURE (Communities United in Response to an Epidemic) mobile website provides fast access to resources, community services, education, content sites and social media channels addressing the current opioid crisis. The CURE mobile website features an interactive, layered ArcGIS map of treatment centers, which can be filtered by services and location for the community and healthcare providers. Coverage area is for the central North Carolina counties of Alamance, Caswell, Chatham, Guilford, Montgomery, Orange, Randolph and Rockingham counties. The CURE mobile website is a product of Greensboro Area Health Education Center (AHEC), with help from Cone Health Medical Library, the Center for Housing and Community Studies (CHCS) at the University of North Carolina at Greensboro and the NC AHEC Program.

Directions for iPhone:

1. Open your Safari browser and go to: curepidemic.com.
2. Tap the **"Share"** icon (the square with an arrow coming out of the top as circled in red to the right) at the right of the screen.
3. Select **"Add to Home Screen"**.
4. A screen appears for you to rename the shortcut, click **"Add"**. The icon has been added to your Home screen.

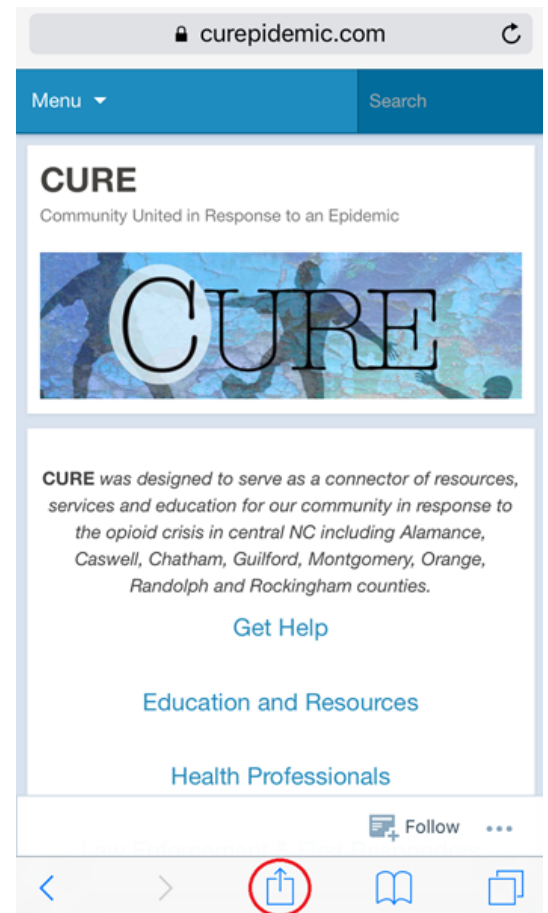
Directions for Android phone:

2. Tap **"Menu"** (the top 3 vertical dots on the far right as circled in red to the right) and wait for the menu to appear from the bottom of the screen.
